GREEN



Are you interested in lessening your salon's impact on the environment and cutting your operating costs? There are simple, inexpensive changes you can make that will produce both positive environmental and financial results. Being efficient and economical saves energy, which in turn saves our planet.

Thoughts to ponder and do when going **GREEN** in your salon:

1. Purchase previously owned furniture and think "Reusing and Repurposing". Second hand doesn't mean second best.
2. Use lots of natural light from windows and skylights.
3. Position your hot water heater close to the shampoo area and remember to insulate it as well.
4. Insulate everywhere i.e. floors, walls, ceilings, and pipes.
5. Buying local products save fuel costs... use things that don't have to be imported.
6. Use reclaimed lumber where possible.
7. Unplug appliances, especially blow dryers at the end of the day.
8. Eliminate plastic and styrofoam cups, buy a reusable large container for tap water. Use glass or mugs for beverages.
9. Adjust your thermostat one degree higher in the summer and one degree cooler in the winter. Each degree Celsius will save about 10% on your energy use! Invest in a programmable thermostat to allow you to regulate temperature based on the times you are closed.
10. Recycle aluminum and glass – twenty recycled aluminum cans can be made with the energy it takes to manufacturer one brand new one.
